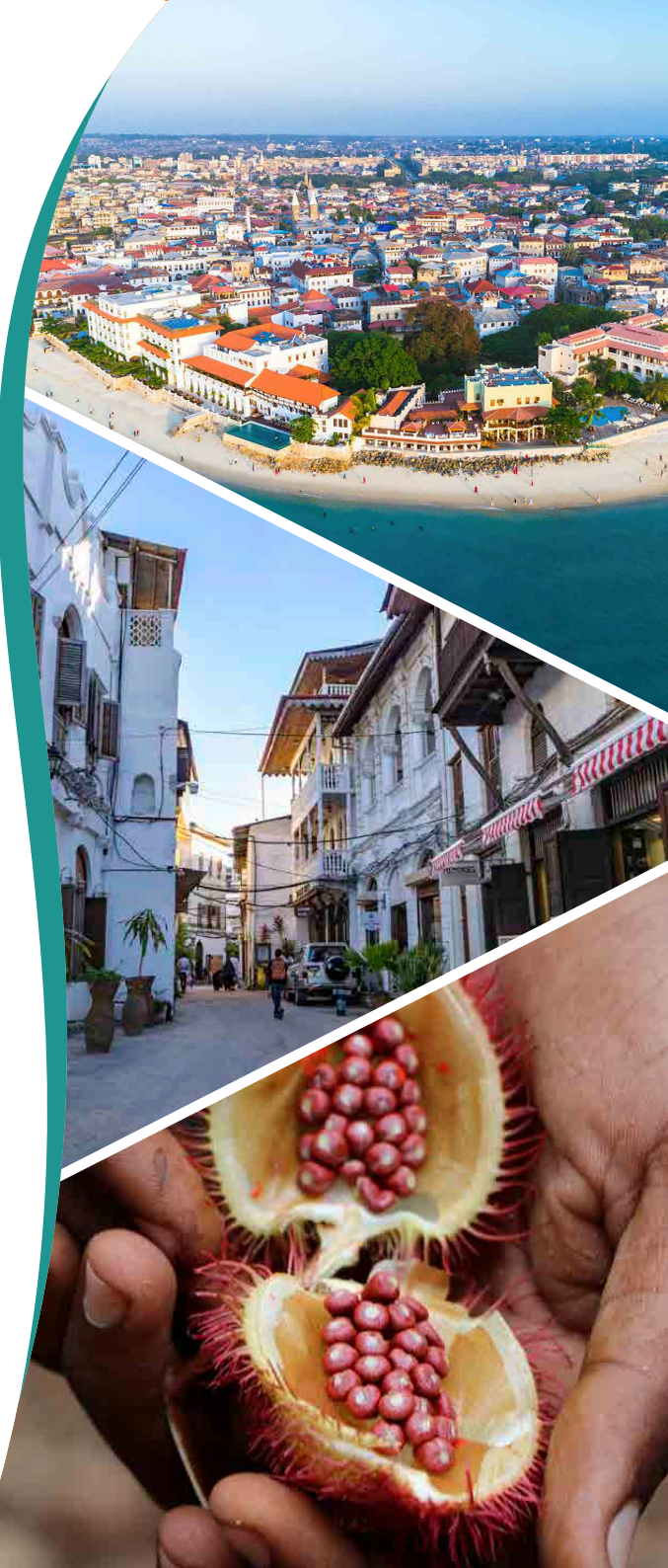
DAY 2:

History & Safari Blue - Sunday, 26.02.2023

W After breakfast, pick up at 08:00 from the hotel for the "Safari Blue Tour", starting from Fumba village. This is a full day trip on locally built sailing dhows, fitted with outboard motors, a sun shade, life jackets and a cooler box of soft drinks – available all day.

Our programme is dictated by nature; we work with the tides. The day includes guided snorkeling over 2 different reefs (equipment is provided), a stop and swim at the sandbank, exploring the magical mangrove lagoon and hopefully spotting some dolphins somewhere during the cruise – the area is famous for them.

Lunch will be served at our restaurant on Kwale island where we have a large stretch tent, sunbeds and The Sand Bar serving up cold beers, cocktails and premium wines and spirits. Our seafood buffet offers lobster, calamari, fish from the grill as well as chicken and jumbo prawns served alongside rice, lentils and delicious vegetarian options. A tropical fruit tasting takes you on a gastronomic "fruit tour" of the wonderful fruits grown on the island.



After lunch, clients can climb up an ancient and fallen baobab tree, relax in the shade, swim at the beach before getting back into the dhow for the return to Fumba village by sail.

Clients arrive back at their hotel at about 17:30. In the evening you will be escorted to Forodhani Garden for open air dinner and then back to the hotels.

A traditional lunch will be served on the way or in one of our partner hotels. Jozani forest is the home for the red colobus monkeys and visit the floating mangrove bridge. Jozani has an excellent nature trail and the guides are well trained and informative. A walk through this impressive flora and fauna is one of the highlights Zanzibar has to offer.

When the sun is going down, you will be transferred to your respective hotel on the East Coast (Paje area) or Stone Town for checking-in, dinner, entertainment and overnight.
